

40N District Meeting Minutes November 12, 2011

Meeting called to order at 1:15

Welcome by DG Shelly Smith included a report that all but four clubs have been visited.

Treasurer's report was given by District Treasurer Lenny Bean. The current balance is \$5125 with anticipated receipts of \$6288 and expenditures of \$3063 for MD dues and \$1000 for USA/Canada Forum. This leaves the district with an anticipated balance for November of \$7,350.09. Lions PDG Bill Whatley asked for an itemized report of expenditures and DG Shelly said she would send that out to him. Lion C Post asked regarding approval of the budget and DG Shelly said she would resend the approved budget along with minutes from the Cabinet Meeting Minutes to her and Bill Whatley.
